We have recognised students who have consistently tried hard to improve their attendance and punctuality, learning and engagement and behaviour for learning. At the end of Autumn 1, a trip was organised to Paradise Wildlife Park which was attended by 14 students and at the end of Autumn 2, students chose ice skating as their trip.


Paradise Wildlife Park:


On 21st October our
